Q. How did Katniss show the Capitol that she is more than their pawn when Rue dies?

Q. How did the people in District 12 earn a living?

A. They were coal miners.

Q. Who was Katniss' hunting partner?

A. Gale

Q. What tools did Katniss use to hunt for food?

A. A bow and arrow, snares and traps and a knife.

Q. Who is the male tribute from District 12?

A. Peeta, the Baker's son.

Q. Where were the Hunger Games held?

A. In the Capitol of Panem in the Rocky Mountains.

Q. Do you think Peeta is in love with Katniss?

A. Yes.

Q. What is an Avox?

A. Someone who has committed a crime against the Capitol and has had their tongue cut out as punishment.

Q. Why is Katniss angry at her mother?

A. Because when Katniss' father died in the mine explosion, her mother went into a depression and Katniss had to hunt for food and care for Prim.

Q. How did stylists Cinna & Portia dress Katniss and Peeta?

A. In black unitards with fluttering capes & headdresses of red, orange and yellow. These were lit with synthetic fire that could not burn them.

Q. Does Katniss' mother work?

A. She is the daughter of an apothecary and makes herbal remedies for the District's injured and ill.

Q. What is a mockingjay?

A. A bird who can repeat a song it has heard.

Q. What gift did Katniss receive from District 11, Rue's farming district?

A. Dark bread shaped in a crescent & sprinkled with seeds.

Q. Who gave Katniss, a gold mockingjay pin?

A. Madge, the mayor's daughter from District 12. She asked Katniss to wear the gold pin in the arena.

Q. Who won the Hunger Games?

A. Katniss Everdeen & Peeta Mellark.

Q. How many Tributes fought in the Hunger Games?

A. 24

Q. What was the rule change in the Hunger Games?

A. That two tributes can win if they are from the same district.

Q. Where did Katniss find Peeta?

A. Camouflaged with mud & leaves by the stream. Peeta had an infected wound in his leg.

Q. What did Haymitch send Katniss after she kissed Peeta?

A. One pot of broth.

Q. Who was watching the Hunger Games?

A. Everyone.

Q. Where did Cato die?

A. In the Cornucopia with the mutated beasts.

Q. Why did the mutations look familiar to Katniss?

A. The beasts had the eyes of the dead tributes.

Q. Did Cato want Katniss to shoot him with an arrow?

A. Yes to stop the attacks from the wild beasts.

Q. What does it mean to say there is no victor?

A. There is no victory in killing.

Q. Who is the president of Capitol?

A. President Snow.

Q. Why did the Capitol change the rules after Cato died?

A. So Katniss & Peeta would have to fight each other.

Q. Why is the Capitol angry at Katniss?
